

This is a step by step to install an app on your desktop or doc that will allow you to launch Plan Plus Online. A few more steps than Auto-Login, but for some of us, we like things pretty.

1. Go to



a. Remember where you downloaded it, we will refer back to it.

2. You need to download and install the fluid app maker, there's a free version. <http://fluidapp.com/>

3. Install and run the app

4. When opened you'll see a screen that looks like this:

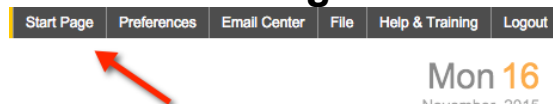

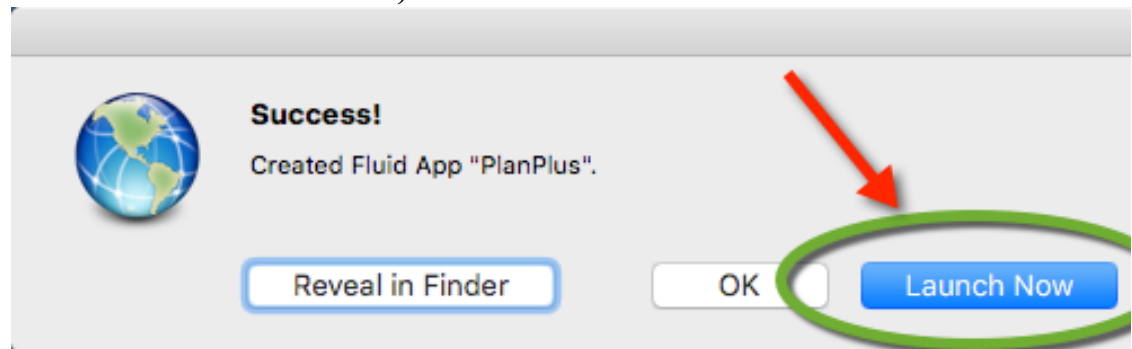

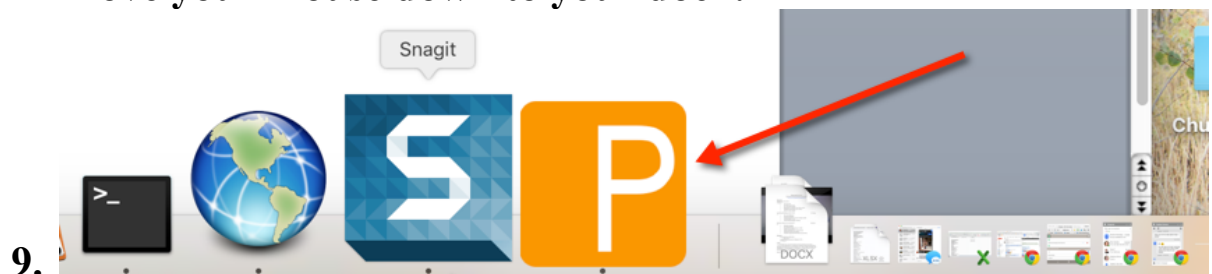

- i. In URL you'll paste the URL you just copied here.
- ii. Name: Name it what you want, (ie: PlanPlus, PPOL, Plan Plus)
- iii. Location: I'd recommend Applications, but just remember where you saved it.
- iv. Click the dropdown arrow and choose "Other" find the Logo you downloaded in step 1.
- v. Click Create
- h. From the next screen, select "Launch Now"

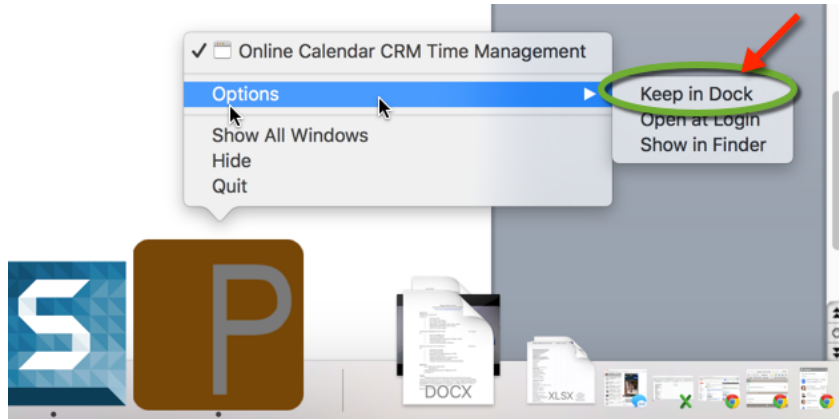
